

Case Manager (Supportive Housing Scattered Sites Mental Health Program, Suffolk County, NY)

The Case Manager will assist with oversight of supportive housing scattered sites and provide rehabilitative and support services to residents. Flexibility may be required for intensive crisis intervention to delay or prevent client hospitalization, as needed. (These services are not reimbursed by Medicaid).

Qualifications and Requirements

- Must be a high school graduate or equivalent (Bachelor's degree preferred).
- Two years of experience working with case management responsibilities in a setting with disabled or economically disadvantaged individuals strongly preferred.
- A valid driver's license and satisfactory driving record are required.
- Must maintain valid First Aid, CPR and Narcan certification.
- Bilingual preferred (English/Spanish speaking).
