

## HCBS Service Provider (Mental Health Program, Suffolk County, NY)

The Service Provider provides HCBS services to individuals in home and community settings in Suffolk County as well as Nassau County if needed. The Service Provider will work with the program participant, treatment team, and Program Supervisor to identify client strengths that promote recovery and facilitate goal achievement. Through a mutually agreed upon goal plan, the HCBS Service Provider will assist the individual in seeking strategies to achieve mental health and health care goals, sobriety, housing stability, vocational training and to prevent where possible, emergency room usage and inpatient hospitalization.

## **Qualifications**

- Bachelor's degree in human services related discipline.
- At least one-year experience working in a setting providing education or case management services to disabled or economically disadvantaged individuals and/or families.
- NYCPS or NYCPS-P a plus.
- Bilingual preferred (English/Spanish speaking).
- A valid driver's license and safe driving record are required.
- Must maintain valid First Aid/CPR and Narcan certifications.
